However, an approach to a tutor which begins "I don't have any idea what this topic is about" is likely to lead to the suggestion that you read your text book and/or lecture notes. Please be well organized before you ask for help! The tutors will be under instructions to spend a maximum of ten minutes with any one student if others are waiting.
